In his encyclical, *Dilexit nos*, Pope Francis instructs us to “nourish our lives with the strength of the Eucharist” in Holy Communion and Adoration, so that we might understand Christ’s love for all more deeply and live out this love ourselves. To celebrate the 250th anniversary of our nation’s independence, the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops has recommended that Catholics devote 250 hours of Eucharistic Adoration. This would be done by groups of people — parishes, friend circles, organizations — who collectively would commit to this time. Our cathedral is open every First Friday for twelve hours of Adoration. This year, why not talk to friends and see if, together, you can make a 250 hour commitment?

NOTE TO FORMER

**SAINTS MONICA AND LUKE PARISHIONERS
AND HOLY ANGELS PARISHIONERS**

With the merger of Saints Monica and Luke into Holy Angels, here are answers to some frequently asked questions.

What happens to the parish sacramental records?

The original books are all being moved to the archives at Holy Angels. Anyone seeking records from St. Monica, St. Luke, or Sts. Monica and Luke, will find them by inquiring at Holy Angels. Currently Holy Angels has the records of several closed or merged parishes and is preparing a more suitable archive room for them.

What about sacred objects? Whatever happens with the building, all religious objects are removed. Some go to nearby parishes, others (such as windows and altars) are stored for future use.

Who pays the bills still incurred at the church building? There are still some expenses that continue, such as NIPSCO, trash, security, wages, etc. These are absorbed by Holy Angels — which is something for ALL parishioners to consider when making your Sunday donations.

Where do the CSA goal obligations go? The CSA obligation is included in the merger. Holy Angels assumes the CSA goal from Sts. Monica and Luke in addition to its original goal. Please keep this in mind while making your own annual donation.

Can we still get into the building? Yes and no. The lower level is still open to those who have original keys. The office and church have been secured with new locks. Only a few people have keys. This is to protect the sacred objects and other valuables. To get into the church someone needs to contact the pastor and be there when the secretary is there.

Can I go and retrieve things? Again, yes and no. NOTHING is allowed out of the building unless the pastor approves. The pastor of Holy Angels has the final word. Gary parishes get “first dibs” on what they will make good use of. Then the facility will be open to other Gary Diocese pastors to see what can be put to good and proper use in their parishes.

What happens to the Soup Kitchen? This is a key ministry for which Bishop McClory wanted to assure continuity. It remains at the Sts. Monica Luke facility until it can be moved to Holy Angels. Plans are being developed to rebuild the kitchen at the Holy Angels school cafeteria and move the ministry to that site. Already, though, Holy Angels is responsible for its income and expense. Please be generous in your donations to that vital outreach to our community.

For the past year and a half at Saint Joseph the Worker, the Franciscan Seculars from St. John serve in collaboration with other partners and parishioners in serving a meal every Saturday. They will also accept donations of food for guests to take home with them. Different groups take turns each weekend, often raising their own funds and preparing meals on their turn. 
July 1
