JESUS WE TRUST IN YOU!

Old Testament 1Kgs 19: 9a 11-13a

Ps 85: 9, 10, 11-12,13-14

New Testament Rom 9:1-5

Gospel Mt 14: 22-33



In our reading from the First Book of Kings God told the Prophet Elijah to Go to the mountain called Horeb for there He would show Himself. This took place after Elijah had proven that there is only one true God by asking God to accept his sacrifice over that of the prophets of Baal. Elijah came to a cave there he would wait for God. Elijah did not find God in the earthquake nor in the mighty wind. No, he found God in a small quite whispering sound. A sound so small that had Elijah not been ready to hear God he would have missed Him. This is the way it is with us we often look for God in strong mighty ways when more often than not he shows Himself to us in small quite ways. If we are not careful, we might just miss Him.

In our reading from Paul's letter to the Romans Paul is lamenting over the Jewish people lack of Faith in Jesus. He reminds us that they were God's chosen people and yet they failed to see Jesus as the Christ. Because of this salvation passed them by or has been delayed for them.

Now why does Paul speak to us about this after all we know and believe that Jesus is Lord and Savior. Paul tells us this so that we do not make a similar mistake and that is to take our salvation for granted. Salvation is not granted to us we must earn it. Yes, Jesus has gained salvation for us but if we do not live a life that is worthy of that salvation it can be lost. We must be a people of mercy and forgiveness. We must open our minds and hearts to see Christ in ourselves and in our fellow brothers and sisters.

In our Gospel taken from Matthew we see a couple of things. First, we see that Jesus goes off to pray. He has just fed over five thousand people with five loaves of bread and two fish. He now goes off by Himself to talk to His Father. Prayer is important to our spiritual lives we must go to the Father and be renewed and refreshed to get that spiritual boost so that we can continue the work of the Lord. Prayer leads to action and action leads to prayer.

Next, we find Jesus walking on the water. Perhaps our Lord intended to walk right pass the Apostle but they saw Him and became terrified. They cried out it is a ghost. Our Lord will call "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid." But this was not enough for them they needed more proof. Peter says "if it is you Lord bid me to come to you on the water." Our Lord call him and he starts to walk on the water but he becomes afraid and he starts to sink. We too some time make this same mistake we fail to recognize the Lord and when He reveals Himself, we want more proof. Peter got the proof he asked for and it was too much for him he began to sink in the water. However, Peter knew who to call upon. He called on the Lord. "Lord save me!" How often do we call on the Lord? Lord save me! Lord help me! Lord grant this prayer! Why we call on God, Jesus or the Holy Spirit does not matter what matters is two things. One we know upon who to call...Lord Save me. And two we have the faith that He will save me. "O you of little faith, why did you doubt? No, trust in the Lord and He will provide all that you need.

Las lecturas de este domingo son: del Antiguo Testamento, 1 Reyes 19, 9a. 11-13a Salmo 85, 9. 10. 11-12. 13-14 del Nuevo Testamento, Romanos 9, 1-5 y del Evangelio, Mateo 14, 22-33



En la lectura del Primer Libro de los Reyes, Dios le ordena al profeta Elías que vaya al monte Horeb, pues allí se le manifestaría. Esto sucedió después de que Elías demostrara que existe un solo Dios verdadero al pedirle a Dios que aceptara su sacrificio por encima del de los profetas de Baal. Elías llegó a una cueva donde aguardaría la presencia de Dios. No encontró a Dios ni en el terremoto ni en el viento impetuoso; lo encontró, en cambio, en un susurro suave y tenue. Un sonido tan leve que, si Elías no hubiera estado dispuesto a escuchar a Dios, se lo habría perdido. Lo mismo nos sucede a nosotros: a menudo buscamos a Dios en manifestaciones poderosas e imponentes, cuando la mayoría de las veces Él se nos revela de manera sencilla y silenciosa. Si no estamos atentos, corremos el riesgo de no percibirlo.

En la lectura de la carta de San Pablo a los Romanos, el Apóstol lamenta la falta de fe del pueblo judío en Jesús. Nos recuerda que ellos eran el pueblo elegido de Dios y, sin embargo, no reconocieron a Jesús como el Cristo. Debido a esto, la salvación pasó de largo o se ha visto postergada para ellos.

¿Por qué nos habla Pablo de esto, si nosotros ya sabemos y creemos que Jesús es Señor y Salvador? Pablo nos lo dice para que no cometamos un error semejante: dar por sentada nuestra salvación. La salvación no se nos concede sin más; debemos corresponder a ella. Es cierto que Jesús ha ganado la salvación para nosotros, pero si no vivimos una vida digna de esa salvación, podemos perderla. Debemos ser un pueblo de misericordia y perdón. Hemos de abrir nuestra mente y nuestro corazón para ver a Cristo en nosotros mismos y en nuestros hermanos.

En el Evangelio según San Mateo, observamos varios aspectos. En primer lugar, vemos que Jesús se retira a orar. Acaba de alimentar a más de cinco mil personas con cinco panes y dos peces. Ahora se retira a solas para hablar con su Padre. La oración es importante para nuestra vida espiritual; debemos acudir al Padre para ser renovados y fortalecidos, recibiendo ese impulso espiritual que nos permita continuar la obra del Señor. La oración conduce a la acción, y la acción conduce a la oración.

A continuación, encontramos a Jesús caminando sobre las aguas. Quizás nuestro Señor tenía la intención de pasar de largo junto a los apóstoles, pero ellos lo vieron y se aterrorizaron. Gritaron: «¡Es un fantasma!». Nuestro Señor les dijo: «¡Ánimo, soy yo; no teman!». Pero esto no les bastaba; necesitaban más pruebas. Pedro dijo: «Si eres tú, Señor, manda que yo vaya hacia ti caminando sobre el agua». El Señor lo llamó y él comenzó a caminar sobre el agua, pero sintió miedo y empezó a hundirse. Nosotros también cometemos a veces el mismo error: no reconocemos al Señor y, cuando Él se revela, queremos más pruebas. Pedro obtuvo la prueba que pidió, pero fue demasiado para él y comenzó a hundirse en el agua. Sin embargo, Pedro sabía a quién acudir: clamó al Señor. «¡Señor, sálvame!». ¿Con qué frecuencia clamamos al Señor? «¡Señor, sálvame! ¡Señor, ayúdame! ¡Señor, concédeme esto que pido!». No importa si invocamos a Dios, a Jesús o al Espíritu Santo; lo que importa son dos cosas: primero, saber a quién acudir —«Señor, sálvame»— y, segundo, tener fe en que Él nos salvará. «¡Hombre de poca fe! ¿Por qué dudaste?». Confía en el Señor y Él proveerá todo lo que necesitas.
